

White Wine

Paso Del Sol Sauvignon Blanc, 2008, Chile

Classic New World Sauvignon Blanc with a powerful aromatic nose. Cut grass, ripe gooseberry & grapefruit flavours.

Pinot Grigio Garganega, 2008, Italy

A pleasant, balanced and fruity wine, with floral notes and hints of pear & apricot.

El Coto Blanco, Rioja, 2008, Spain

Made from macerated Viura grapes with slow fermentation. Offers an intense aroma of flowers & green apples, and is full

Crystal Brook Unoaked Chardonnay, 2008, South Australia

Crisp, dry and elegant, retaining typical ripe tropical fruit but completely unoaked.

Gavi Balbi Soprano, 2007, Italy

Italian dry white, characterized by a fresh honey bouquet, this is fruity and aromatic with mineral notes and a tangy citrus finish

Mitchell Reisling, Watervale, 2007, Western Australia

This wine should dispel any misunderstanding as to how gorgeous a Riesling can be. This is subtly dry. The palate delivers a fresh, aromatic and exotic flavour with a powerful tangy character.

La Val, Albarino, Rias Baixas, 2007, Spain

A slight spritz on the tongue characterizes this dry white and ensures its freshness. Hints of peaches, apricots & limes.

Gewurztraminer Alsace Hugel, 2006, France

This wine is luscious and intense, tasting complex and of fragrant herbs, releasing wonderful aromas of lychees & peaches.

Churton Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, 2007, New Zealand

A beautiful Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. This has a lovely, crisp citrus freshness and zing. Aromas of gooseberry & white peach.

Pinot Blanc Alsace Hugel, 2005, France

Hugel is one of the finest producers in Alsace. This is smooth, dry & elegant with a floral bouquet and hints of Elderflower.

Sancerre Blanc Henri Bourgeois, 2007, France

Sancerre is a fine quality Sauvignon Blanc from the Loire valley. Exceptional gooseberry fruit from one of the best producers in the Sancerre region.

Matua Valley Sauvignon Blanc, Hawkes Bay, 2007, New Zealand

A classic example of NZ Sauvignon Blanc, showing lively, zingy, zesty fruit, ranging from tangy pink grapefruit to rich ripe melon.

Chablis Jean Marc Brocard, 2006, Burgandy, France

The King of Chardonnay, dry and pure. Great elegance, subtle lemony fruit and flinty, mineral flavours.

Pouilly Fume Les Moulins à Vent, 2006, France

This classic Loire Sauvignon Blanc acquires the term 'fume' from the distinctive gunflint aromas. On the palate it is crisp with fresh fruit flavours notably gooseberry and grapefruit.

Moreson Premium Chardonnay, Franschoek, 2006, South Africa

Ripe melons and citrus on the nose with undertones of wood and vanilla. Our favorite Chardonnay

Chateaneuf du Pape Blanc Domaine Font de Michelle, 2006, France

A unique blend from the Rhone white grape varieties of Roussanne, Marsanne and Chasan, producing a full-bodied, rich and fragrant wine with peaches and apricots on the nose, with a touch of spice on the finish.

Puligny Montrachet Gerard Chavy, 2001, Burgundy, France

Burgundy is one of the finest areas in the world for producing Chardonnay. Gerard Chavy produces fabulous wines from his small Estate. Flavours ranging from cream and sponge cake to orange peel with citrus freshness with great depth on the palate.

Meursault, Domaine Michelot, 2004, France

A Burgundy Cote de Baune Chardonnay, classic wine with orange blossom, smoky bacon, grilled brioche and nuts on the nose. A palate of wonderfully rich fruit, balanced with good acidity, clear oak and buttery. Elegant with excellent length.

Rosé Wine

Pink Pinot Grigio, Pasqua, 2008, Italy

A pleasant, pale pink, balanced and fruity wine. Hints of peach skin and green melon.

Terra Sana Rosé Organic Vin de Pays d'Oc, 2007, France

Hand selected organic grapes from South West France are transformed into delicious flavours of ripe strawberries and raspberries. Perfect for spring and summer drinking.

Sancerre Rose Les Jeannettes, Henri Bourgeois, 2007, France

A wonderful example of a Pinot Noir rose from the Loire valley. It's dry, elegant and delicate with scents of wild strawberries and raspberries.

Red Wine

Paso Del Sol Merlot, Central Valley, 2008, Chile

Dark cherry red colour with a vibrant nose, aromas of red berries and eucalyptus. Lightly oaked and well rounded on the nose.

Crystal Brook Shiraz, 2007, South Eastern Australia

Bright purple, red with attractive berry notes and subtle creamy aromas, but big, bold and full of body. This is a cracker, full of black fruit and chocolate flavours with a spicy peppery finish.

Alta Vista Classic, Malbec, 2007, Argentina

Bright violet – red colour. Aromas of red fruit particularly plums, vanilla notes and subtle coffee touches.

El Coto Rioja Crianza, 2006, Spain

Medium bodied with soft, succulent raspberry and subtle soft spices. Aged for over 12 months in American oak adds creamy and vanilla characteristics. Dangerously moreish!

Mission Estate Syrah, 2007, New Zealand

A new world wine produced in an old world style. Spicy aromas and good fruit intensity make way for a more elegant, tannic and smoke flavoured finish.

Cote-du-Rhone Organic Chapoutier, 2007, France

Deep ruby in colour with a wild and earthy nose showing vibrant Syrah fruit offset by a hint of spice.

Moreson Pinotage, Coastal Region, 2007, South Africa

This Pinotage is dark with vibrant violet tinges and a fusion of red berry fruit. Intense cherry and raspberry flavours combining with sweet oak aromas, vanilla and cocoa.

Valpolicella Superiore Vigne Nuove di Musella, 2007, Italy

A blend of Corvina, Molinara and Rondinella grapes. This is a seductive plump fruited wine of bitter cherries, raisins, chocolate and vanilla. It is a mature wine with great depth.

Museum Real, Cigales, 2003, Spain

Rich and ripe berry fruit flavours combine with a heady mixture of chocolate, liquorice and spice to make this exceptional Spanish red.

Ad Astra, Nittardi, Toscana, 2005, Italy

Ad Astra is a unique and individual wine made from Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot & Syrah grapes with a hint of Sangiovese. It's medium bodied with red berries and plums, hints of liquorice and cedar on the finish. A remarkable wine.

Churton Pinot Noir, Marlborough, 2006, New Zealand

Gem of a hand picked Pinot Noir from a small private vineyard. Ruby red that exhibits black cherry, earth, raspberry & spice. Fantastic.

Mercurey Domaine de Suremain, Burgundy, 2004, France

Silky soft Pinot Noir. Summer fruits, hints of pepper with earthy notes and a gentle touch of oak.

Chateauneuf Du Pape Domaine Font De Michelle, Rhone, 2006, France

This classic southern Rhone includes a blend of Grenache Noir, Syrah and Mourvedre. It is deep and lively, garnet in colour. This superb Wine has intense aromas, predominantly blackcurrants but also notes of leather, truffles and spices. Really impressive.

Volnay Boillot Burgundy, 2004, France

A classic Pinot Noir with focused red fruit profile that is laced with earthy truffle and a hint of spice on the finish. This has been variously Described as "meaty", "substantial", "tannic", "robust", "spicy" and "austere".

Nectar Dei, Nittardi, Toscana, 2004, Italy

This is our favorite Italian wine. A wonderful nose that teases you into a deep inhale and then a long contemplative sip. This is a wine of tremendous quality, elegance & finesse. Perfect with a grilled rib-eye steak. Aromas of dark cherries and other red berries and notes of earth.

Chateau Rauzan Segla Margaux Bordeaux, 1996, France

There is a lovely character on the nose here, which exhibits aromas of dark, slightly floral, rather nutty fruit. It is quite fluid and has wonderful style. This wine pleases with a creamy presence and close to perfect structure. If we could afford it, we'd have a glass every day.

Champagne & Sparkling Wine

Lindauer Brut, New Zealand

Consistently one of the most sought-after sparkling wines. Predominantly mad from Chardonnay & Pinot Noir grapes. Fresh citrusy fruit and a zingy finish.

Cloudy Bay Pelorus, New Zealand NV

A stunning, elegant sparkling wine. It's classy with apple fruit flavours and a toasty roundness on the palate.

Cockburn & Campbell Special Cuvée Brut, Champagne

Unbeatable House Champagne from the house of George Gardet. Subtle buttery and lemony fruit flavours combined with hints of biscuit.

Nyetimber Classic Cuvée Brut, England

A highly acclaimed wine from West Sussex that's truly remarkable. Aged on its lees for a minimum of 5 years developing balance, richness and complexity of character.

Laurent Perrier Brut, Champagne NV

An immensely popular Chardonnay Non-Vintage Champagne with resulting lightness and elegant depth and richness. It's divine.

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut, Champagne NV

A superbly rich and full Champagne. Great depth with a fine balance of fruit and mature, toasty aromas.

Cristal Brut 2002, Champagne (Very Limited Availability)

This is the prestige Champagne from the house of Louis Roederer. Probably one of the finest Champagnes in the world. Great style & elegance.
